Avila Pier Community Meeting - On Thursday, March 15, 2018, the Harbor District held a Community Meeting at the San Luis Yacht Club to provide an update and answer questions concerning the Avila Pier. Participants were asked to provide input on a “feedback” sheet regarding their comments about the rebuilding of the Avila Pier. 
