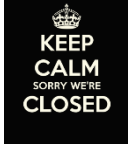




Greetings from Port San Luis Harbor District June 2018 Newsletter

- Conference with legal counsel regarding the matter of *Lowry v. Port San Luis Harbor District*.

Open Session included 1 Presentation, 10 Consent items and 8 Discussion items, the discussion items were as follows:

- FYE 2017/18 Budgetary Transfers: Budgetary Transfers for Fiscal Year End 2017/18; approved.
- Public Hearing to Approve FY 2018/19 Annual Budget: Receive public comment and approve Final Budget; Resolution 18-11 adopted approving budget.
- Public Hearing – Mooring Permit Revocation: Mooring #703; mooring permit revoked.
- Avila Beach Community Center: Review request for Fee Waiver for event; fees adjusted & discretionary funds provided.
- Fish Market Request for Proposals: Review the draft RFP; RFP approved.
- Mitigation for Emergency Coastal Development Permit No. G-3-14-0025: Review mitigation and corresponding funding, approved.
- Consolidation of 2018 General Election: Adopt Resolution 18-12 to consolidate with SLO County General Election; resolution adopted.
- Federal Surplus Property Program: Adopt Resolution 18-13 authorizing District staff to view and purchase surplus items from State and Federal Government; resolution adopted. .

Please bring your own gloves, picker and trash receptacle, if possible. “After the Holiday” Beach Cleanups proved to be very successful in both 2016 and 2017 and the District is pleased to continue with the tradition. The District also thanks both residents and visitors for their help in keeping the beaches clean and looks forward to those continued efforts this year. Through the increased efforts from residents and visitors, we have seen a positive change in behavior and we are hoping to sustain that change long-term. As District Crews are very busy during the weekend and holidays, we are most appreciative of the public’s

assistance keeping the beaches litter free.

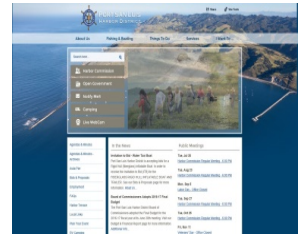
