Closed Session included 4 items:

- Conference with legal counsel regarding the matter of *Lowry v. Port San Luis Harbor District*.
- Conference with Real Property Negotiators – Fat Cat's Café.
- Conference with Real Property Negotiators – Olde Port Inn.
- Public Employee Performance Evaluation – Harbor Manager.

Open Session included 10 consent items, 1 presentation and 10 Discussion items, the discussion items were as follows:

- Election of Officers: President, Vice President and Secretary for 2019 were elected.
- FY 2017/18 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report: Report by Badawi & Associates; received and filed.
- Commercial Fishermen's Gear Storage Relocation Discussion: Reviewed input to date and discussed potential options; no action.
- Port Advocacy Plan Update: Status update on Port Advocacy Plan; reviewed update, no action.
- Public Hearing to Consider Amendments to Code of Ordinances Chapter 22 – Violations and Enforcement (Parking Citation Bail Amounts): Opened Public Hearing and received public comment; adopted Resolution 19-02.
- Committee Assignments: Reviewed President's recommendations for 2019; received and filed.
- California Marine Affairs and Navigation Conference (CMANC) Washington Week: Attendees determined for the 2019 CMANC Washington, DC week.
- Local Agency Investment Fund (LAIF) Resolution: Adopted Resolution No. 19-03 for LAIF transfers.
- Annual Financial Workshop: Discussed of topics for workshop; date selected.
- GovInvest Software Purchase: Reviewed proposal for 5-year agreement to provide analytical software; approved.

Bait Barge Removed from the Mooring Field – the iconic "bait barge" was removed from the mooring field in January. The barge was no longer used for bait service and was removed in a joint effort that included Port San Luis Harbor District Staff and Port San Luis Boatyard.



FAQ's – What is Happening with the RV and Tent Camping Project – Harbor Terrace - The Harbor District has made steady progress on readying the Port for the project, those efforts include:



- Notifying Trailer Boat Storage patrons that the last day for their vessels in storage is March 31st.
- Working to temporarily relocate the Gear Storage Units to a nearby location.
- Reorganizing and downsizing the Harbor Districts equipment and supplies in anticipation of a temporary relocation.
