

Port San Luis Sport Launch - COVID-19 Precautions

(Effective 5/9/2020 Until Further Notice)

PSL Sport Launch and PSL Harbor District will conduct a limited trial opening of the sport launch. As we move forward, operation of the Sport Launch is completely contingent on adherence to the new COVID-19 Launch Procedures and Rules regarding social distancing. In order for PSL Sport Launch to operate, we **MUST** adhere to the State and County shelter in place order which specifies recreating in your neighborhood and limiting discretionary travel.

- 1) We are allowed 45 trucks with trailers per day. NO Exceptions.**
- 2) The Port San Luis Parking lot will NOT be open for trucks and trailers until 30 min before the Sport Launch opens – every day.**
- 3) No entering Port San Luis Parking lot until 5:00 a.m.**
- 4) No overnight parking allowed - Strictly day use from 5:00 a.m. - 4 p.m. daily.**
- 5) The Fish Cleaning Station is CLOSED, you must clean your fish at home.**
- 6) The boat wash is limited to two stations.**
- 7) Must wear a mask at all times when outside your vehicle.**

This is a limited trial, if our boaters do not follow this new procedure or break any of the new rules, you will not be able to launch your vessel.

Port San Luis Sport Launch - Launch Procedure

(Effective 4/24/2020 Until Further Notice)

1. Please designate 1 person per boat to pay for the launch, purchase bait, tackle and ice. **Only ONE Person in the store at a time.**

(Designated person Must know the length of your boat and if the trailer is slotted)

2. MUST WEAR A MASK AT ALL TIMES WHEN OUTSIDE VEHICLE AND AT ALL TIME WHEN INSIDE THE STORE.

3. Please prepare your boat for launch before pulling into the launch bay, our staff will handle the straps and launch the boat. Prior to launch, your fishing crew can wait on the dock (with masks on). The driver must stay in the vehicle during the launching procedure, then park your vehicle and proceed directly to the dock to retrieve your boat and vacate the dock as soon as possible.

4. Must maintain a 6ft Minimum distance. Please respect our employee's and launch operators by keeping your distance at all times.

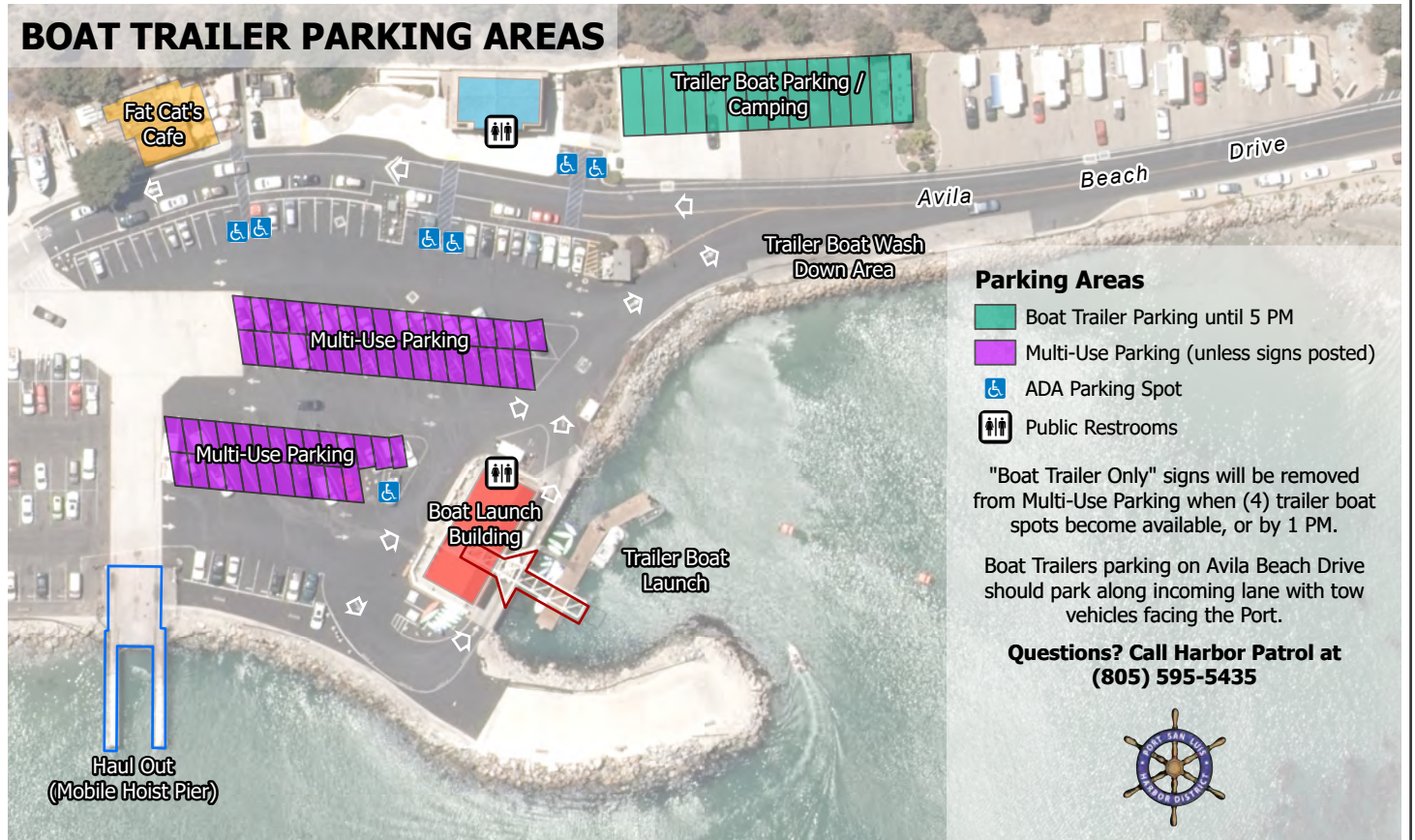
5. Truck and trailer parking available in the immediate parking lot. Day parking ONLY, Overnight parking is prohibited! (See Map on reverse side for Truck and Trailer parking)

6. Fish cleaning station – CLOSED.





7. Do not congregate in the parking lot, at the launch or on the dock. Stay In your vehicle and do not gather in groups.

Parking Areas

-  Boat Trailer Parking until 5 PM
-  Multi-Use Parking (unless signs posted)
-  ADA Parking Spot
-  Public Restrooms

"Boat Trailer Only" signs will be removed from Multi-Use Parking when (4) trailer boat spots become available, or by 1 PM.

Boat Trailers parking on Avila Beach Drive should park along incoming lane with tow vehicles facing the Port.
