

## **Chronology of Events:**

### **October 2020**

- Submitted Coastal Development Permit application to Coastal Commission for the Rehabilitation of the Avila Pier.
- Secured letters of support from Assemblyman Jordan Cunningham & Senator Bill Monning to be used for grant applications.

### **November 2020**

- Awarded \$250,000 from Coastal Conservancy for Avila Pier Rehabilitation.
- Met with Division of Boating and Waterways to discuss pre-award reporting requirements.
- Received 100% Repair Plans from Moffatt and Nichol.

### **December 2020**

- Reviewed Avila Pier Repair Plans and engineer's estimates from Moffatt & Nichol.
- Provided responses to Division of Boating and Waterways for Avila Pier Landing Grant.

### **January 2021**

- Received updated quote for landing repairs from Moffatt and Nichol. These were needed to finalize the District's funding request with Division of Boating and Waterways.
- Received quotes and options for replacement light fixtures.
- Pier experiences storm damage, 4 piles lost and recovered.

### **February 2021**

- Complied & submitted Avila Pier Plume and pier survey documents to Coastal Commission.
- Submitted updated application materials to Division of Boating and Waterways (DBW) for grant.
- Submitted Grant Agreement and resolution to State Coastal Conservancy for grant.

### **March 2021**

- Submitted cultural resource information to DBW for Avila Pier Landing Grant.
- Sent Avila Pier corrections to Moffatt and Nichol.
- Submitted proposed Avila Pier repair methods to Coastal Commission.
- Met with MKN regarding utilities replacement.

### **April 2021**

- Met with Coastal Commission staff, Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) staff, and Moffatt & Nichol consultants regarding the CDP for the Avila Pier Rehabilitation.
- Contacted three diving contractors to discuss Avila Pier repair methods.
- Met with Tom Swen of Friends of Avila Pier to discuss fundraising and project status.
- Submitted Community Project Funding Grant application.

## **May 2021**

- Corresponded with SLO County regarding Avila Pier material staging. Reviewed County's Land Use Ordinance and zoning designations for surrounding parcels.
- Worked with (RWQCB) to provide Coastal Commission additional information for Avila Pier.

## **June 2021**

- Received proposal from MKN for Avila Pier Utility Replacement Design.
- Drafted Minor Use Permit application for Avila Pier Project storage yards.
- Met with Wildlife Conservation Board to discuss Avila Pier Rehab project.

## **July 2021**

- Issued notice to proceed to MKN for Avila Pier Utility design.
- Provided DBW ADA compliance letter from Rengel + Co. Architects for Avila Pier Landing.
- Prepared and submitted map of repair types and consolidated BMP list to Coastal Commission.
- Met with DBW representatives regarding landing configuration and status of award.
- Contacted State Office of Historical Preservation (OHP) to initiate Records Search.
- Met with Wildlife Conservation Board (WCB) representative to review grant budget and projected construction timeline.

## **August 2021**

- Met with PG&E personnel to seek potential lighting or funding donations.
- Provided ADA exemption letter for landing and Records Search results to Division of Boating & Waterways.
- Met with California Conservation Corps reps for site visit of pier to assess potential involvement with decking repairs.

## **September 2021**

- Received Coastal Development Permit (CDP) for rehabilitation of the Pier.
- Notified granting agencies of Avila Pier Rehab CDP approval (WCB, SCC, DBW, ABCF, and FOAP).
- Obtained field measurements of terminus structures, updated CAD repair plans with footprints.

## **October 2021**

- Presented Avila Pier Concepts to the Board for potential improvements beyond critical repairs and donor recognition.
- Presented Tom Swem a resolution in recognition of his efforts for the Avila Pier Rehabilitation and inaugural President of Friends of Avila Pier (FOAP).
- Attended Friends of Avila Pier meeting to participate in donor recognition discussion.
- Met with Wildlife Conservation Board to follow up on permitting requirements.
- Responded to various inquiries from WCB and Division of Boating and Waterways (DBW) regarding federal permits.
- Received Historical Resource Compliance Memo from USACE and provided to WCB.
