**RESOLUTION 21-19**

**ASSIGNING CalPERS RETIREE  
JOHN D'ORNELLAS THE POSITION OF INTERIM HARBOR MANAGER  
(GOVERNMENT CODE §21221(h))**

**WHEREAS**, John D'Ornellas is listed as a retired employee in the California Public Employees' Retirement System ("CalPERS");

**WHEREAS**, the Harbor Manager position became vacant as of November 11, 2021, and a recruitment is in progress; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to retain efficient and uninterrupted operations and management of the Port San Luis District, the Port San Luis Harbor District Board of Commissioners hereby appoints John D'Ornellas as Interim Harbor Manager to perform the duties of Harbor Manager for Port San Luis Harbor District, including management of the District and the District's employees, effective November 17, 2021;

**WHEREAS**, in compliance with Government Code section 21221(h), John D'Ornellas shall serve as Interim Harbor Manager and shall not exceed the 960-hour work limitation in a fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS** this appointment will end the day immediately preceding the date of the permanent appointee to the vacant Harbor Manager position commences his/her employment or, if earlier, the date this appointment is terminated by either the District or Mr. D'Ornellas; and

**WHEREAS**, the employment shall be limited to four days per week during the appointment; and

**WHEREAS**, the current Harbor Manager is a salaried position with a base monthly salary of \$16,480 and the hourly equivalent of approximately \$95.08; and

**WHEREAS**, the hourly rate paid to John D'Ornellas will be \$92.00; and

**WHEREAS**, John D'Ornellas has not and will not receive any other benefit, incentive compensation in lieu of benefits or any other form of compensation in addition to the hourly pay rate; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Government Code section 21221(h), this employment shall not interrupt or result in the loss of John D'Ornellas' benefits provided by CalPERS; and

**WHEREAS**, the entire appointment document between John D’Ornellas and the Port San Luis Harbor District has been reviewed by this body and is attached herein; and

**WHEREAS**, no matters, issues, terms or conditions related to this employment and appointment have been or will be placed on a consent calendar; and

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Port San Luis Harbor Board of Commissioners hereby certifies the nature of the appointment of John D’Ornellas as described herein and detailed in the attached appointment document and that this appointment is necessary to fill the position of Harbor Manager due to a vacancy effective November 11, 2021, and during a recruitment for the position because there is a significant need for management of the District and the District’s employees which needs to be completed with the specific expertise and skill set John D’Ornellas possesses.
